CSA President Ernest Logan Responds to DOE Matching of Restart Schools and Educational Partnership Organizations

We understand that state education law mandates that schools identified as “restart” be matched with an EPO, but we find it curious that public schools would be removed from what should be the responsibility of school superintendents and placed under the management of private entities. CSA has been in intense discussions with the DOE to ensure that restart schools and current and new transformation schools receive the instructional, financial and operational support including equity in enrollment that is due them under the School Improvement Grants. We will also work to monitor the EPO-DOE relationships to ensure that the state law and contractual rights of our members continue to be monitored.
